

The Canadian Francophone Games Presents Their Spokespeople

Edmonton, June 25, 2008 – Fifty days before the Games, The Canadian Francophone Games are proud to present their two spokespersons, Danielle Peers and ZPN. Ms Peers will represent the Leadership and Sports components and ZPN will represent the Arts.

Danielle Peers is a Francophile from Edmonton, but mostly she is one of the best athletes of her time in wheelchair basketball. She was on the national team from 2003 to 2007. She brought home a Bronze Medal from the Athens 2004 Paralympic Games. More recently she has been named Basketball Canada's 2007 Outstanding Athlete, and was a finalist for the 2007 International Sportswoman of the Year.

ZPN's (David Muipatayi) path confirms all the passion that inspires him, while revealing an exceptional creator. As a multi-talented artist, unifier, producer, rapper, author, composer and performer he draws on the wealth of diversity of his Congolese (ex-Zaïre) origins and of his adopted country, Canada, to bring us a distinctive sound.

Those two persons will be present during the Games to share their passion with the participants and give the medals to the athletes and artists.
