What are the JeuxFC?

First held in 1999 in Memramcook, New Brunswick, the Jeux de la francophonie canadienne (JeuxFC) take place every three years. For the very first time, it is **Regina, Saskatchewan** that will host the 9th edition of the JeuxFC.

BY and **FOR Youth**, the event ranks among the largest gatherings of French-speaking youth in Canada, welcoming young people aged 14 to 18 from all 10 provinces and 3 territories.

- encourages hundreds of youth to showcase their talents across three streams (arts, leadership, and sports);
- fosters cultural pride, self-confidence, and leadership skills in a spirit of healthy competition;
- provides an exceptional opportunity to bring together the Fransaskois community and celebrate the French language.
- are an initiative of the Fédération de la jeunesse canadienne-française (FJCF), made possible through the ongoing support of the Government of Canada.

VISION

The JeuxFC is a national event BY and FOR youth that inspires engagement by awakening and strengthening the sense of belonging to the Canadian Francophonie.

MISSION

By celebrating diversity and fostering identity development among youth, the JeuxFC contribute to the vitality of French-speaking communities across Canada.

Why Regina? Why Now?

Since 1999, Saskatchewan has been sending its youth to the Jeux de la francophonie canadienne. In 2028, it is finally our turn to welcome them. **After 25 years of waiting, Regina becomes the beating heart of the Canadian Francophonie** — and the Fransaskois community, driven by a remarkable demographic renewal and an engaged youth, is ready to shine before the entire country.

A Historic First

Saskatchewan has never hosted the JeuxFC since their creation in 1999. 2028 is our moment to showcase the beauty of the Prairies and the richness of Fransaskoisie to French-speaking youth across the country.

A Community in Full Renewal

Newcomers, engaged youth, strong institutions — the Fransaskois community is at a turning point, uniting its energies around a shared project after the pandemic years.
